Dear Parents and Carers

In 2021 World Book Day, just like everything else, will be different.

We've tried to adapt and plan so we can ensure that World Book Day sends a powerful and positive message about books and reading, even in lockdown. Just as we would if we were in school, we will be spending the day celebrating reading.

For the day, we are continuing with our 'What on Earth' topic. Instead of buying or making a new outfit, we are asking children to recycle an old costume they have used before. This will hopefully ensure no new outfits need to be bought and add a little creativity to pupils' outfit choices. Where possible, pupils should try to dress as a character from a favourite story! If you do not wish to recycle a costume, your child may wear their pyjamas for their day of remote learning!

There will be lots of activities on the day, including online story telling sessions, remote visits from authors and lots of talking and reading books. One activity your child will be asked to do is to create a 'book in a box or bag'. This task requires your child to get creative, use recycled materials to showcase their favourite book in a box! They may wish to draw or make the characters from a story, design the setting and add quotes – be as creative as you wish!
