Southgate trip to STEAM Museum

Dear Parents / Carers

This term, our big question that underpins our learning is, **How has life changed?** Our history pathway looks at transport and trade and we are excited for the children in Southgate to visit STEAM – Museum of the Great Western Railway on **Tuesday 12th March** to bring their learning to life.

Children will be taking part in a workshop that explores the impact of the invention of the steam engine and steam locomotives in Victorian Britain. They will also complete activities within the museum that look at what life was like working in the railway factories at that time.

We will be leaving school at **8:50 am** and will be back in time for normal school pick up **at 3.30pm**.

Children will need to wear full school uniform. Please also ensure they bring a rucksack containing a packed lunch and a water bottle. (No chocolate, sweets or fizzy drinks please). **If your child is entitled to Free School Meals a lunch will be provided for them if you request one at the bottom of the form.**

The cost for this is **£13 per child**. This should be paid for via ParentPay by **Monday 4th March**. As school has already significantly subsidised part of the cost, if we have insufficient contributions, the trip will unfortunately not be able to go ahead.
