This needs to be pre payed before the day to guarantee a Christmas lunch for your child. Payment will be required for Years 3-6 only. There is no charge for Phase 1, Year 2 or children who are entitled to free school meals.

Last day of term and we will be finished at the normal time (end of the school day at 3:20pm). The children will be watching movies and playing games. If there is a board game your child loves please do bring it in. No electronic games please.
