Humanity means forgetting our selfish interests at times when others need our help.

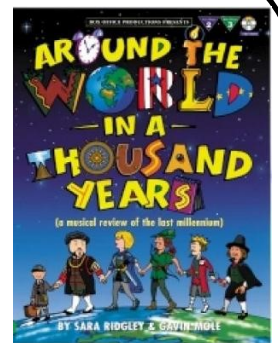
Around the World in 1000 Years!
