Free School Meals

Universal infant free school meals (UIFSM) provides funding for all government funded schools to offer free school meals to pupils in reception, year 1, and year 2. If you're child is currently in year 2 we recommend that you apply for free school meals as you will be charged going forward which will start in September.
