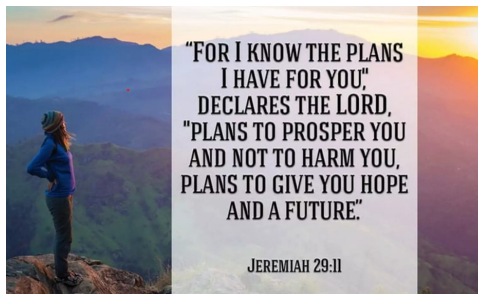

What is HAF and HAP?

This winter Gloucestershire City Council are offering four days of activities and events for children and young people eligible for benefits related Free School Meals.

This programme, called the Holiday Activities and Food programme (HAF), is **funded by the Department for Education**. That means that for you, there is NO COST! It is absolutely FREE!

The HAF programme's purpose is to make sure children and young people are entertained, active, educated, safe, and fed between 19th and 22nd December.

Using grant funding, this offer is now available to **all children and young people across Gloucestershire** through the Holiday Activities Programme (HAP). So you can attend, even if you don't qualify for free school meals. It is FREE for EVERYONE!

How will it work?

Each day from 19th to 22nd December, activities and events across the county will be available either in person, or online. Each district area will have its own page so you can find activities closest to you and what is being offered. You can book your activities from 1st December.

Some in-person activities will also need you to sign up in advance, so the providers know which children and young people are coming to join that day's fun and games. A meal or food kit will also be provided, dependant on each district's offer.
