We are pleased to continue with the success of our Religious Worship team to support with the teaching of RE and help lead our Collective Worship each week.

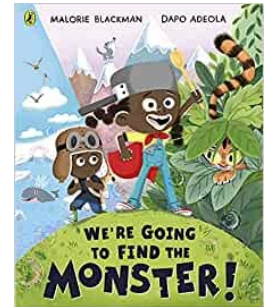
