Let's Keep Learning - see the blog and Microsoft Teams for an overview of this week's learning. This informs you of our topic and the types of things to discuss with your child.

Work pack - this will be delivered to your home on Thursday 7th January. These activities are for the next 10 days and correspond to the learning outlined on the Let's Keep Learning document. We will provide another work pack on Monday 18th January.

We will be providing a live phonics lesson at 9am every day.

There will be a live Maths lesson at 11am every day.

There will be a live Literacy lesson at 12pm every day.

For all live lessons, please look out for a Teams invitation on your child's email and Teams account. These lessons will last approximately 30 minutes. Please ensure your child is ready with their pencil and work book, provided in their work pack last term.

Although we have outlined the activities we would like your child to complete, please feel free to take part in additional activities you feel may support their learning.

We love to see children learning! Please take photographs of the activities your child completes and upload them to Tapestry for us to see. We can then congratulate your child on what they have achieved whilst at home and support them with anything they may have found difficult.
